Tinting agent for interior and facade paints

1. Description, Application

DIPI Koncentrat is a pasty agent for tinting interior and exterior wall paints, water-based topcoats for wood and metal up to pastel shades.

DIPI Koncentrat is not suitable for tinting silicate, silicone and lime paints or as an independent coating. It is made from quality inorganic and organic pigments and is available in 9 color tones.

2. Colour Shades

- DCK05 (yellow), DCK15 (orange), DCK25 (red), DCK35 (violet), DCK45 (ochre), DCK55 (brown), DCK75 (green), DCK85 (blue) and DCK95 (black).

4. Instruction for Use

Blend DIPI Koncentrat into the wall paint by hand or with an electric mixer. The maximum amount of DIPI Koncentrat in individual products is 2% vol. (200mL per 10L) for JUPOL Classic or JUPOL Citro products, or 5% vol. (500mL per 10L) for JUPOL Gold, JUPOL Acrycolor and JUBIN Decor Universal.

Wash the tool thoroughly with water immediately after use.

Store the rest of the tinting agent in a well-sealed container for later use.

5. Storage, Transportation Conditions and Durability

Storage and transportation at temperatures between +5°C and +25°C, protected from direct sunlight, out of the

reach of children, IT MUST NOT FREEZE!

Shelf life when stored in an originally sealed and undamaged packaging: at least 24 months.
